**The Competition**

The Competition is open to LAC members and LAC Visitors (two prizes)

The aim of the competition is to land your aircraft as near as possible to a large SPOT which has been marked on the runway.

You may take a passenger (or fellow pilot or flying instructor) in your aircraft.

The Circuit is to take off from the preferred runway, climb to 800 feet QFE and then turn to the south.

Announce your intentions over the Safety Com frequency.

Using your own judgement, fly down wind, base, then finals and land with your wheels as close as possible to the large spot.

You be scored by how close to the spot you are when you touch down, the pilot closest will win.

**Small Print**

Please Land at KHF and register your intention to take part in the competition.

You must execute a normal landing.

You may fly the pattern and landing with engine power, flaps or approved slide slips and you can confer with your fellow pilot.

If you feel the landing is unstable or unsafe, you must execute 'a go around'.

Please remember you will be flying in the low level corridor and you must always be below 1300 feet on Manchester's QNH and you must keep a good lookout for other aircraft in the low level corridor.
